

PROJECT BENEFICIARIES AND STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION

I. PROJECT OBJECTIVE AND BENEFICIARIES

The Project aims to improve the water supply system of Silay City Water District. The new project will directly benefit 51,726 people through the installation of additional 2,410 service connections and a total of 8,710 service connections up to the design year 2020. These include the increase in water supply and storage capacity. Also, the increase in water system pressure during the PEAK HOUR DEMAND is one of the main aims of this project.

II. PROJECT SCOPE AND COVERAGE

The proposed construction additional Ground Reservoir and Boosting Facilities will benefit the concessionaires in the areas of Brgy. Guinhalaran, Brgy. Mambulac, and parts of the poblacion. We can provide an adequate and higher water pressures on the said areas.

The proposed Waterline Extension located at Bangga Sawmill, Brgy. Mambulac, and Sitio Dap-dap, Brgy. Lantad will provide opportunities for the new applicants to avail our services. At least 100 households or 550 individuals will benefit on this expansion.

The proposed 1,620 meters Transmission pipeline extension (200mm diameter) from the Tresfuentes Bridge up to the proposed well site at hda. Maquina, Brgy. Rizal will provide opportunities for the applicants in the area. There were an on-going subdivision development with an estimated of 2,000 households that can be serve.

Presently, Silay City Water District is serving ten (10) out of sixteen (16) barangays of Silay City, Negros Occidental.

III. PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

The project will be funded by the Development Bank of the Philippines. The implementation will cover a period of 12 to 15 months from the start of construction activity. This includes the program preparation, public bidding, materials acquisition, mobilization, construction, project completion and acceptance.
