SWAC – SILAY CITY **W**ATER DISTRICT **A**CTIONMAN ON EVERY **C**OMPLAINTS

- **1.** Always check your faucet / taps from leaks.
- 2. Check regularly your water meter. Try to close all your faucets then find out if the flow indicator is rotating. If yes, absolutely you have a leakage. Better to call a plumber to trace and fix it.
- **3.** Report illegal connections, service & mainline leakages and defective water meters to your water district.
- **4.** Check also your water closet tank from overflow. Replace tank fittings if necessary.



5. Avoid excessive use of water. Utilize your basin when washing kitchen utensils. Use water in a glass, instead of flowing water when brushing your teeth.

- **6.** Replace / repair leaking pipes and fittings. Never forget to close the valves and faucets after using.
- 7. Never use sub- standard or low quality pipes and fittings in your in-house pipelines. Exposed plastic pipelines should be properly supported and anchored.
- **8.** Better to cover with cement all PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride) and P.E. (Poly ethylene) tubing pipelines for their protection.
- **9.** Use proper P.E. tubing adaptors on tapping points. Avoid sleeving and using of rubber straps in jointing your pipes and fittings.
